

# Cat Colony

## What You'll Need...

- Dustpan and broom
- Disinfectant
- Towel (Use a new towel for each colony that you clean)
- Litter scooper
- Cat brush (if necessary)

## Steps

### 1. Removing Contents

First, remove all mats, towels, litter boxes, beds, bowls, and toys from the floor of the colony.

### 2. Cleaning the Floor

Sweep the floor of the colony and gather all the dirt, litter, and cat food into a pile. Collect it in a dustpan and throw it in the trash can.

### 3. Cleaning the Walls

Using a towel and disinfectant, wipe down the walls of the colony.

### 4. Returning Contents

Begin returning contents to the colony such as toys and beds. Wipe down beds with a towel or brush them with a cat brush to remove hair. Return mats and blankets to the colony only if they are clean. If they are dirty then take them to laundry and get fresh ones.

### 5. Litter

Scoop the cat litter and add litter if needed (this is demonstrated in the cat cage cleaning video). Return the litter boxes to the colony.

### 6. Food and Water

Fill up the food bowl and refresh the water (both tasks are also shown in the cat cage cleaning video).
