JOB SUMMARY:

Under the direction of the Kennel Coordinator the Animal Care Technician is responsible to: maintain humane and sanitary conditions for animals; monitor the health and progress of animals; provide a warm and welcoming environment in the shelter for potential adopters and visitors; and develop a respectful, congenial relationship with fellow employees of the VBSPCA.

Performs in this position in accordance with the organization's expectations for animal care, teamwork, and interpersonal relations, and actively contributes to improving service delivery, communication and consistency.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Perform timely, effective, properly executed cleaning protocols throughout the shelter.
- Ensure the shelter is clean, sanitary, and presentable by removing animal waste during open hours and clearing donations and debris from walkways and the front lobby.
- Maintain the overall look of the building and grounds. Report any concerns to area coordinators.
- Responsible for implementing the day-to-day care of the animals, including their health and mental well-being.
- Implement enrichment programs and behavior modification protocols as indicated by coordinator.
- Counsel individuals regarding adoptions, obedience training, and pet care.
- Continue education regarding companion animal behavior and care.
- Fully participate in shelter protocols to offer all visitors superior customer service.
- Perform other duties as assigned by the coordinator.

KNOWLEDGE AND SKILL REQUIREMENTS:

- High School Diploma or GED
- Experience working with animal welfare organizations and basic animal care knowledge is preferred.
- Customer Service experience.
- Basic level computer skills using various standard office programs such as Word and Excel or other similar type programs.
