Thank You from CEO and Board Chair



Puddles, Duncan, Bear...these are just a few of the names of almost 4,000 homeless pets who found their way to the VBSPCA and into our hearts this year.



Puddles was rescued from floods in the South when one of our staff members joined a disaster response team deployed to Florida and Louisiana. After amputation of an injured leg in the VBSPCA clinic, Puddles found a loving home with one of our board members, where Puddles is one of two VBSPCA tripods in the family.

Duncan is an affection feline who came to us with severe disease in both eyes. After removal of one eye and valiant efforts to save the other, the second eye had to be removed. Duncan is beloved by all VBSPCA staff and has become one of our best pet therapy and humane education ambassadors. Staff have witnessed Duncan's tail and whiskers growing longer to accommodate for his loss of sight.

Bear was transferred to us from another shelter after being rescued from outdoor life. Bear was a rambunctious boy who needed some help with his behavior. His adoption included a free 6-week training class at our Happy Paws Training facility.

Bear's energy and enthusiasm proved helpful in scoring touchdowns in the Animal Planet Puppy Bowl, where the VBSPCA made its first appearance this winter. Bear was awarded MVP, Most Valuable Puppy, for his talents on the field and off. You will read more in this newsletter about the healing Bear helped to bring to one of our foster families.

Thanks to the VBSPCA's continued growth this year, we were able to offer Puddles, Duncan, Bear and many other animals the care and rehabilitation they needed to live happier and healthy lives.

The VBSPCA's veterinary clinic has grown from two veterinarians to five veterinarians over the past three years. Our vets and their support staff provided care to over 11,000 public patients last year, in addition to providing care for the shelter animals and injured wildlife.

The number of injured and orphaned wild animals the VBSPCA assisted soared by 48% last year, to almost 3,000 animals. The number of adoptions in our shelter, over 3,600, was the most ever in our history. Our live release rate was 90%.

With the VBSPCA's rapid growth over the past four years from an operating budget of less than \$3 million to over \$4 million, we have reached full capacity for the services we are able to offer in our current facilities.

As part of our Strategic Plan, a new Facilities Committee has begun to evaluate our long-term facility needs. A grant from the Mason Foundation will enable us to engage a shelter planning consultant to conduct a formal needs assessment in the coming year.

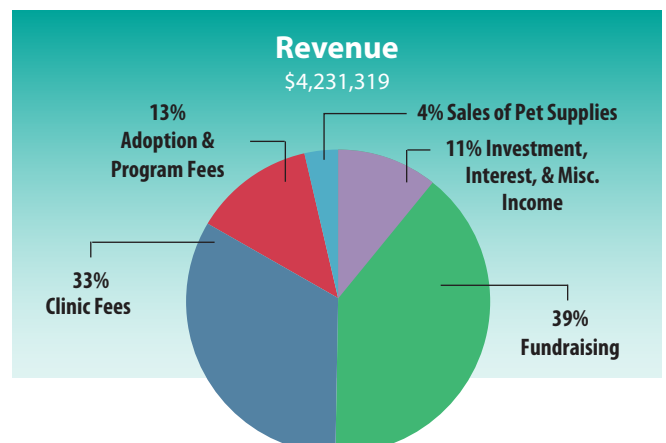
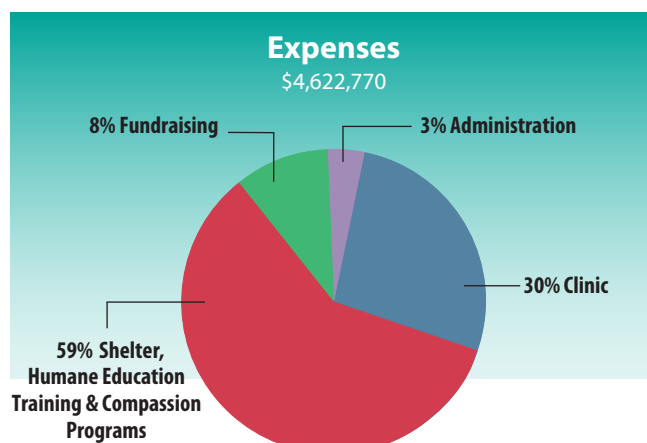

Celebrating the Human-Animal Bond

Shouts of excitement rang through Smartmouth Brewery Pilot House on Sunday February 4th, when Bear was announced as Animal Planet's Puppy Bowl XIV MVP (Most Valuable Puppy). Virginia Beach SPCA staff, volunteers, and supporters had gathered to celebrate and watch the Puppy Bowl. For the first time ever, the televised event featured three pups from the VBSPCA.

Long before Bear's rise to fame, he was a foster puppy. Rescued from an impoverished area of rural North Carolina, Bear was transferred to the Virginia Beach SPCA at just eight weeks old. He was too young to be adopted, so he was placed in our foster program where he received care until he was ready for the adoption process. The VBSPCA foster program cares for almost 1,100 animals each year. This includes many orphaned kittens and puppies, like Bear, whose immune systems are not yet fully developed and require additional care.

Bear was fostered by the Robey family, a dedicated family of five who began fostering puppies in 2016. The Robeys turned to our foster program after their youngest child, Lauren, was diagnosed with Leukemia. Unable to commit to adoption during her treatment, they hoped that the presence of foster puppies would bring some joy and happiness into the home. Lauren and Bear were able to provide comfort to one another in their healing processes.

Lauren is now in remission, and the family continues to foster. They have fostered well over 60 puppies! Lauren's older brother, Drew, is a regular volunteer at our Pet Supplies and Adoption Center.

Wildlife Rehabilitation

During the 2017 year, the Virginia Beach SPCA accepted 2,878 injured or orphaned wildlife. The state of the art radiology and laboratory equipment at the VBSPCA Clinic enable the veterinary staff to act quickly and save lives. A separate Wildlife Treatment Room at the shelter provides a quiet, reduced-stress area for wildlife patients, and streamlines their initial care before they are delivered to local rehabilitators. One of the many animals saved last year was a Great Blue Heron that Animal Control retrieved from Stumpy Lake. The heron's wing had been pierced with a fishing hook that still had the fishing line attached. The heron was brought to the Virginia Beach SPCA, and staff were able to successfully remove the hook from between

the bird's radius and ulna. After surgery, the heron was transferred to a local, licensed wildlife rehabilitator. In a few weeks, the heron was well enough to be returned to the wild and was released back into the Stumpy Lake ecosystem.

The Virginia Beach SPCA is proud to partner with Pets for Patriots. This program assists active and retired military members in the adoption of adult shelter pets, large dogs and special needs animals – those most in need of a loving, forever home. To ease the financial costs associated with pet ownership, Pets for Patriots provides a minimum 10% discount on medical care during the pet's lifetime. Pets for Patriots offers access to additional cost reductions for pet basics, such as 25% off adoption fees, a free bag of pet food, and 25% off collars and leashes. In 2017, our mobile Neuter Scooter spayed and neutered over 2,500 animals! We expanded our reach to new areas in Virginia Beach, Portsmouth, Suffolk, Williamsburg, and Onley, making frequent stops at the Oceana NEX, Northwest NEX, Norfolk NEX, and Yorktown NEX. The Neuter Scooter makes scheduling spay and neuter surgeries a breeze, especially for Military families, and it makes a big impact on animal overpopulation issues in Hampton Roads.

Creating a more humane and responsible community goes beyond finding forever homes for pets. It means that we also provide pet owners with high quality and humane food, toys, and pet products, ensuring that companion animals and their families are equipped with what they need to have a successful life at home. This is one of the reasons why the VBSPCA opened the Pet Supplies & Adoption Center in 2015, and it is why we carry select pet products at all of our locations.

One product that we are particularly excited about is the Harness Lead, a product that allows owners to confidently walk their dog with less pull and without putting pressure on the neck. Our staff took to the Virginia Beach Boardwalk during this past Neptune Fest, and we let dog walkers try out the Harness Lead. Not only did we sell out of this excellent product, but dog owners walked away with a humane way to harness their pets.

Harness Lead is made from a double branded nylon that is hand spliced in the USA. Constructed in the same way as dock line, it is strong enough to hook a boar and withstand up to 3,700 lbs of pressure. Harness Lead uses no leather parts, making it a vegan, cruelty free leash. It reduces pull, it is escape resistant, it fits all shapes, and it reduces chafing. We are proud to be the only Harness Lead retailer in all of Hampton Roads, and we sell them onsite at all of our locations.

Teaching Compassion

Little Donors, Big Hearts

This past autumn, we received a few big donations from a few kind and compassionate animal lovers. Jedi, Elodie, and Reese all asked for donations to the VBSPCA instead of birthday gifts. Jedi, who turned 9 this past October, donated just over \$1,000 in pet supplies. Elodie, who turned 4 in November, raised \$830 for the shelter, along with an in-kind donation of pet supplies totaling close to \$200 in value. Reese, who turned 9 in November, also made an in-kind donation, with a value of over \$200. These generous kids prove that you don't have to be big to make a big impact.



Compassion Classroom

During 2017, our Compassion Classroom program was held in 56 Virginia Beach and Norfolk public schools. Approximately 4,000 students participated in the program, just one of the VBSPCA's many programs for youth. Compassion Classroom results showed a 10% increase in positive attitudes, compassion, and knowledge about animal responsibilities.

Vet for a Day

In 2017, we expanded our Vet for a Day program to include an intro and advanced syllabus. We also created a program for home school children. This all day workshop offers participants the opportunity to listen to animal heartbeats, tour the shelter and clinic, and sometimes even peek into the surgery suite during an active surgery! Participants get to look at x-rays and identify the types of animals featured. They also get to examine a preserved heart from a dog who had Stage IV heartworm and learn about the importance of heartworm prevention. Finally, our VBSPCA veterinarians take time answering all of their questions about what it's like to be a vet.

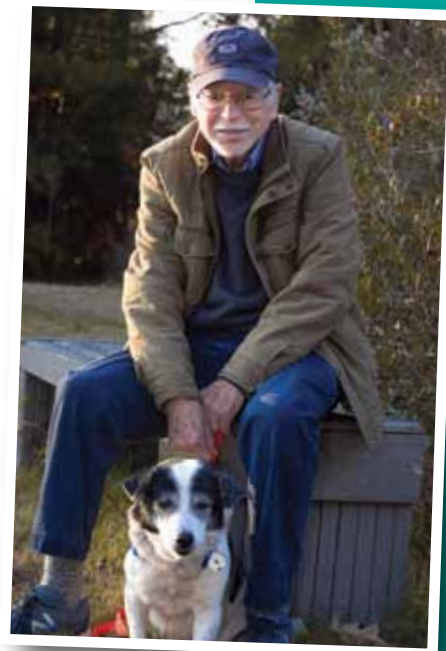
Volunteer Spotlight
