


Make a Bunny Bookmark



1. Gather your supplies:

Origami paper (or any paper that is cut into a square)
Scissors & Glue
Markers, colored pencils, or crayons
Additional colored paper (optional)

2. Fold your square piece of paper in half diagonally from corner to corner.

3. Take the top layer of paper and fold down the tip until it touches the bottom straight edge.

4. Fold both the left and right corners of the triangle inward to meet the tip you just folded to the bottom center of the triangle. Then unfold both corners.

5. Take the left corner of the triangle and fold it upward to meet the highest peak of the triangle (this is the bottom layer triangle tip). Repeat with the right corner.

6. Tuck the tips of both the left and right corners into the pocket that has formed between the bottom and top layers of the triangle. You've now made the base to your corner bookmark, where you'll tuck the page you're on into the little pocket.

7. Use another piece of paper in the same color to cut out two rabbit ears. Glue them to your bookmark. You can also use another color paper to make the inside of the ears!

8. Cut out eyes, a nose, and a mouth with teeth. Glue those pieces to your bookmark. You can also draw the eyes, nose, mouth, and even whiskers!

9. Start reading! When you're ready to stop, slide the bookmark onto the corner of your page so you remember where you left off.
