It applies to our mission; to our staff; to our community in need; to our supportive donors; but most of all to the animals, both in and outside the walls of our shelter or clinic. Adapting to change and overcoming challenges is a daily exercise in animal welfare but it is NEVER a

solo one. It takes all of us working together in many differing situations to find the best solutions for the greatest outcomes. I have said this in the past, but it resonates loudly with me over the past year of changes: we can't do this work alone. It involves open communication, willingness to listen, strong work ethic, empathy, passion for the animals, and compassion for each other. Over the past few months, we have settled into our newly renovated clinic- learning to work in expanded spaces with new equipment. Social Media Helps Find Homes for Long-Term Residents

At the heart of every animal shelter is a simple hope: that each animal who comes through our doors will one day walk out into a loving forever home. For some, that journey takes a little longer but thanks to the support of our community, a few of our longest residents finally found their perfect match.

Through heartfelt posts on Facebook and Instagram, we shared the stories of animals who had been with us for extended periods—not because they lacked love to give, but because they just hadn't been seen by the right person. What followed was nothing short of inspiring.

Among those adopted was Eddie Munster, a sweet soul who spent 140 days in our care. And then there was Victoria, an 8-year-old cat who spent 206 days with us. During her time here, she received the medical and dental care she needed to feel her best. Despite the challenges, Victoria remained gentle and loving, winning hearts along the way. We're so happy to share that she has now found her forever home, where she'll be cherished.

Every animal's story is unique, but some stand out as powerful reminders of resilience and hope. Espresso has faced more than her share of hardships, but today she's a living testament to the healing power of love and care.

Espresso's story began under heartbreaking circumstances. After giving birth to six puppies, her owners, unwilling to care for the litter, took the puppies away from her and abandoned them in a cold, dark shed. Left behind, Espresso was heartbroken and confused. Some of her puppies did not survive the harsh conditions, but thankfully, compassionate neighbors noticed what was happening and stepped in. They brought Espresso and her surviving puppies to our care, and that's when her healing began.

But her struggles didn't end there. Espresso also suffered from a serious eye condition where her eyelid was not properly developed. The condition caused her pain, and after evaluation, our veterinary team determined that removing her affected eye was the best way to prevent further complications. The surgery was successful, and Espresso made a full recovery. But the emotional trauma from her past continued to affect her.

Understandably, Espresso developed anxiety from her experience of such trauma. Yet, despite her difficult past, she showed remarkable resilience. With the care she received, she slowly learned to adapt to life with one eye. Her anxiety is still something she's working through; but day by day, Espresso is becoming more confident, trusting, and content in her new surroundings.

Today, Espresso is discovering the simple pleasures in life. Her journey has been long and challenging, but she made incredible strides. Espresso's story is a powerful reminder that no matter how difficult the past may be, there is always hope for a brighter future. She is a true example of resilience with the greatest outcome-Espresso and all of her puppies have been adopted!






















Keeping Healthy Pets in Loving Homes with Affordable Care

At the Virginia Beach SPCA, our mission is rooted in compassion, quality care, and community. Every day, we work to ensure that animals not only find loving homes but stay in them—healthy, happy, and supported.

According to the recent PetSmart Charities-Gallup State of Pet Care Study released in April, "97% of pet parents consider their pets as family." Yet, despite this deep bond, the study also revealed a troubling gap: more than half of U.S. pet owners (52%) skipped needed veterinary care in the past year, and 7 in 10 who did so cited financial barriers as the reason.

These statistics reflect what we see in our communities. Pet ownership is a source of joy and emotional connection, but for many, the rising costs of care create difficult choices. That's why the Virginia Beach SPCA remains steadfast in our commitment to keeping pets healthy and in their homes, which we believe is essential to reducing shelter intake numbers and promoting humane communities.

The VBSPCA operates the only full-service, low-cost veterinary clinic in the region, offering essential pet care to the public and to the animals in our shelter.

From spay/neuter procedures to preventative care and treatment for illness or injury, we work hard to remove the financial barrier that can sometimes stand in the way of responsible pet ownership.

Our mobile clinic extends this reach even further, meeting pet owners where they are—especially those in underserved areas and rural communities like the Eastern Shore.


Last year, thanks to the PetSmart Charities Accelerator Grant, we expanded our clinic spaces and services to serve even more pet owners and shelter animals.

This generous funding allowed us to increase appointment availability, add critical equipment, expand treatment areas, and continue serving our community partners in animal welfare.

As we look ahead, our dedication only grows stronger. With continued support from organizations like PetSmart Charities, our generous community of donors, and the growing network of local partners, the VBSPCA continues to seek solutions that address the root causes of pet relinquishment-starting with access to care.
